## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROCTORS**

Proctors must meet several requirements:

- Proctors may NOT be a friend, roommate, neighbor, classmate, co-worker, employee, social media acquaintance, pet, or have any appearance of a relationship with the student.
- Proctors cannot have a conflict of interest or have any vested interest in the student's grade or performance on his/her exam.
- The supporting documentation (i.e. a Valid ID Card) must be submitted before a proctor can be approved.
- Proctors must be **at least** 21 years old.
- Arrangement between students/ parents and the proctor will be reached on a time and place to take the exam.
- Proctors must have adequate and reliable access to the internet, including email services.
- Proctors must be available on the agreed exam day to unlock the exam for the student.
- Proctors should allow at most two hours to take an exam (as stipulated in the examination guidelines), plus some time to sign in and open the exam.
- StellaPride Academy has the right to contact the proctor directly to validate his/her identity and to assure that he/she meets all the requirements. If SPA rejects a proctor, the student/ parent will be notified accordingly, and it will be the student's sole responsibility to provide another proctor.
- The proctored exam must be taken within the stipulated period.
- It is the student's/ guardian's/ parent's sole responsibility to have all necessary means required for taking the proctored exam (e.g. a computer with internet access).
- The proctor should receive an email from SPA with the student's/ guardian's/ parent's personal details and a code to access the final exam if given. It is the student's sole responsibility to verify that their proctor received such an email.
- If the proctor did not receive such an email at least three (3) days prior to the commencement of the exam period, the student must contact the office of the Administrator (talktostellaprideacademy@outlook.com) immediately and report that his/her proctor failed to receive the email.
